

Myocardial Perfusion Imaging Study (MPI)

Myocardial perfusion imaging (MPI) is a non-invasive imaging test that uses a special camera to show the blood flow and function of the heart muscle. The test results can help your provider determine if you have heart disease or may be at risk for a heart disease event, such as a heart attack. An MPI is often called a nuclear stress test.

Wear: ✓ Comfortable walking shoes ✓ Loose fitting layered clothes (department is kept cool) 	 Results: ✓ Your exam will be interpreted by a physician specialized in nuclear cardiology. Follow-up with your ordering provider. ✓ Please allow 5-7 working days for your provider to review the results.
